Descriere: Inspections, maintenance service, repairs and occasional supply of gymnasium equipment to the MOPAC estate. The Estate covers 32 boroughs within the Greater London area, and a number of other locations on the outskirts.— Planned maintenance is to be carried out to relevant sites across Greater London. The maintenance frequencies shall be determined by the importance of building categories across the MOPAC estate.— The Supplier shall provide a reactive repair/replacement of gymnasium equipment service generally during normal working hours; however the minimum response time for category 2 reactive works shall be 3 days with rectification in 5 days to ensure that all gymnasium equipment is operational, safe and secure at all times.— The Supplier shall provide annual inspections and corrective work, in order to maintain compliance. The frequency of these shall be determined by the location and need, be it statuary or best practice across the MOPAC estate. Inspection compliance is required to ensure MOPAC's statutory duties under the Health and Safety at Work, Act, the Management of Health and Safety at Work Regulations, the Working at Height Regulations. - The Supplier shall provide the occasional supply of gymnasium equipment as and when required and agreed by the Authority.
